Terms of Program:

1. Rigging company will apply to USITT to be considered for the program. If approved, company name will be added to the pool of contractors listed for each state.
2. Company will be chosen by individual school from pool of approved contractors. Both school and rigging company will be notified of the funding allowance from USITT based on the system descriptions provided by the school to USITT. Rigging company will have the option to accept the inspection job with full understanding of the established fee or decline the job.
3. Company will schedule inspection and training with the school's faculty or staff. Inspection and training will take place on the same trip which might be over several days' time depending on system size.
4. Should inspector find imminent danger in the rigging system, inspectors can 'red tag' or 'tie off' equipment to prevent an accident.
5. Inspector will submit an invoice to USITT detailing the location and dates of work done. This will prompt payment from USITT.
6. If requested, contractor agrees to allow the school to record the training session for future use.
