## **Adapter**

Device that transitions between two or more dissimilar types of connectors

Synonym: Reverser, Sex Changer, Turnaround

## **Air Packs**

Portable modules small enough for air transportation that can be assembled to control audio and multimedia feeds

## Amp Room

See also: Rack Room

## **Amplifier**

Electronic equipment that increases the level of a signal

## **Amplifier Room**

See also: Rack Room

#### **Analog**

Variable signal continuous in both time and amplitude

#### **ATSC**

Advanced Television Standards Committee - the North American television standard that defines high definition and digital protocols for broadcasting

#### **Automation**

See also: Show Control

#### **Automation Control System**

See also: Show Control

## **Automation Operator**

Person responsible for the automation control system

## **Automation Programmer**

Person responsible for establishing cues for a computerized control system

## **Balanced Signal**

Type of audio signal with two conductors plus shield

## **Banana Connector**

Plug that has non-locking pins with spring sides Synonym: Banana

#### **Beta**

#### Betacam

Trade name (Sony) See also: Camcorder

## **BlueRay**

Enhanced optical digital recording disk format developed to hold high definition video content

#### **BNC Connector**

Bayonet Neill Concelman locking connector used with coaxial cables Synonym: Baby N, Bayonet Nut Connector, British Naval Connector

#### **British Naval Connector**

See also: BNC connector

#### Cable Tie

Locking plastic strap used to bundle or attach loose items Synonym: Ty-wrap, Wire Tie, Wire Wrap, Zip Tie

#### Camcorder

Combination video camera and recorder in a portable size for hand held field production

Synonym: BetaCam, DigiBeta, DV-Cam

#### **Camera Head**

Manually controlled apparatus that allows for pan and tilt of the camera Synonym: Friction Head

#### **Camera Platform**

Permanent or temporary platform on which a camera is located

#### Carousel

See also: Slide Projector

#### Cassette

See also: Magnetic Tape

#### **Cassette Deck**

See also: Tape Deck

#### Cat 5

See also: Ethernet Cable

#### Cat 5e

See also: Ethernet Cable

#### Cat 6

See also: Ethernet Cable

## Category 5

#### CD

Media used to optically record and playback digital content, typically data or audio files

## **Ceiling Mount**

Hardware that attaches equipment to the ceiling

#### Co-Ax

See also: Co-Axial Cable

#### **Co-Axial Cable**

Two conductor cable with one insulated conductor centered inside a shielded outer conductor

Synonym: Co-Ax

## **Component Video**

Analog method of processing and distributing video signals using three separate visual channels

Synonym: RGB-HV, Pb, Pr, Y, Y-B, Y-R

## **Composite Video**

Standard USA method of processing and distributing video pictures where all visual and synchronized information is carried on one combined signal Synonym: NTSC

#### **Cordless**

#### **Cradle Screen**

See also: Roll Up Screen

#### Crash

System failure

## Digibeta

See also: Camcorder

#### **Digital**

Information represented by a string of numbers

## **Digital File**

Group of discrete values recorded in electronic form

#### **Digital Light Process**

Texas Instruments type of solid state visual data capture and projection Synonym: DLP®

## **Digital Projector**

Optical electronic system that projects an image from a digital source

#### **DLP**®

See also: Digital Light Process

#### **Dressed Cables**

Cables run in a neat and secure manner

## **DTV**

See also: Digital Television

#### **DV-Cam**

See also: Camcorder

#### DVD

Media used to optically record and playback digital audio and video content and data

#### **DVD Deck**

Usually an installed unit See also: DVD Player

## **DVD Player**

Machine for playback of DVD media

#### **DVD Recorder**

Has recording capability and is usually portable See also: DVD Player

## DVI

Digital Video Interface - standard and connectors for linking digital video devices

## **Earwig**

See also: Personal Monitor

# **Equipment Rack**

See also: Rack

#### **Ethernet Cable**

Wires and connectors that are specified for Ethernet signals Synonym: Cat 5, Cat 5e, Category 5, Cat 6, Category 6, Network Cable

#### **Ethernet Router**

Switching or electronic patching system that sends digital signals from one source to several destinations

#### **F** Connector

Screw-on round coaxial cable connector Synonym: RF connector

#### Fast-Fold®

Trade name (Da-Lite®) See also: Folding Frame

## **Fiber**

See also: Fiber Optic

#### **Fiber Optic**

Technology that uses glass or plastic threads (fibers) to transmit data via light

Synonym: Fiber

#### **FireWire**

Trade name (Apple) See also: IEEE 1394

#### **Fluid Head**

See also: Camera Head

## Fog Screen

See also: Water Screen

## **Folding Frame**

Collapsible structure for attaching screens

Synonym: Fast-Fold®

## **Folding Frame Screen**

Projection surface, front or rear, attached to folding frame

#### **FP Screen**

See also: Front Projection Screen

#### **Friction Head**

See also: Camera Head

## **Geared Head**

See also: Camera Head

## **Gray-Scale**

Standard reference chart used to calibrate luminance and contrast in a video system

#### **Grommeted Screen**

Projection surface designed to be stretched and attached to a frame

## **HDMI**

#### **HDTV**

See also: High Definition Television

## **High Definition Television**

High quality digital with wide screen format

Synonym: HDTV

## **High Impedance**

Electronic input/output circuits with an impedance of several thousand

ohms or more Synonym: High Z

## **High-Definition Multimedia Interface**

Audio/Video digital transmission connector system for uncompressed

video

Synonym: HDMI

#### **Hot Head**

Trade name (Sony) See also: IEEE 1394

#### **IEEE 1394**

Protocol for high speed digital data transfers Synonym: FireWire, i.LINK®

#### **IMAG**

Image Magnification See also: Large Format Display

Trade name (Media Cybernetics®) See also: Slide Projector

#### In-Ear

See also: Personal Monitor

#### **Inflatable Screen**

Projection surface and structure supported by air pressure

#### **JumboTron®**

Trade name (Sony) See also: Large Format Display

# **Keystone Effect**

Projection distortion where one side appears larger than the opposite side

# L

## **Large Format Display**

Video display utilizing various technologies to present the image usually on a large screen

Synonym: IMAG, Jumbotron®, LED

## LCD

See also: Liquid Crystal Display

## **LED**

See also: Light Emitting Diode

## **Light Emitting Diode**

Solid state device that glows when electrically activated Synonym: LED

#### **Line Splitter**

See also: Splitter

## **Liquid Crystal Display**

Digital data display Synonym: LCD

## **Magnetic Tape**

Storage media used for recording and playback of audio, video and/or data

Synonym: Beta, Cassette, MiniDV, U-Matic, VHS

#### **Media Router**

Switching or electronic patching system that sends audio and video signals from one or more sources to several destinations

Synonym: Press Box

#### Mic Splitter

See also: Splitter

#### MIDI

Musical Instrument Digital Interface is a standard for electronic control of musical values

#### Mini-DV

Format for recording digital video and audio on a very small video tape cassette See also: Magnetic Tape

#### Mist Screen

See also: Water Screen

#### **Monitor**

See also: Video Monitor

#### **Monitor Wall**

Array of video monitors

#### **Monochrome Monitor**

Monitor that displays video images or computer data in a single color

#### **Motion Picture**

Film based system

## **Motion Picture Projector**

Film based system for moving image projection

#### **MP3**

Format used to encode audio and or video content

#### **MPEG**

The Moving Picture Experts Group - a working group of the ISO (International Organization for Standardization) and a system of five standards they created for the digital encoding of audio and video

#### **Network Cable**

See also: Ethernet Cable

#### **NTSC**

See also: Composite Video

## **Opaque Projector**

Optical system that reflects light from an object onto a surface

#### **Overhead Projector**

Projects 8.5 x 11 inches and larger transparencies

# P

#### **PAL**

Television system developed by the British and used in most Commonwealth nations

#### Pan

Horizontal movement of a camera

#### **PANI**

Trade name (PANI Projection and Lighting Vertriebs GmbH) See also: Slide Projector

## Pb,Pr

See also: Component Video

#### **Personal Monitor**

Earphone style audio monitor that is fitted into the artist's ear Synonym: Earwig, In-Ear

#### **Phono Connector**

Friction contact center pin and a nonlocking sleeve used for two conductor wires

Synonym: RCA, RCA phono

#### **Picture Sheet**

See also: Rear Projection Screen

#### **PIGI®**

Trade name (E/T/C Audio Visuel) See also: Slide Projector

#### **Pixel**

Smallest digital picture element

## **Plasma Display**

Flat surface display covered with millions of microscopic glass bubbles filled with plasma

## **Playback Person**

See also: Tape Operator

## PLC

See also: Show Control

## **Programmer**

Person who inputs information into control systems

## **Projection**

An image in light

## **Projection Screen**

See also: Rear Projection Screen

## **Projection Surface**

Material that will display images.

Synonym: Screen

#### **Projectors**

Device using light to create still and/or moving images on a surface

# R

#### Rack

Portable or permanent rack that contains equipment Synonym: Equipment Rack, Rack Mount, Rack Rails

#### Rack Mount

See also: Rack

#### **Rack Rails**

See also: Rack

## **Rack Room**

Room in which equipment racks are located Synonym: Amplifier Room, Amp Room

## **Radio Frequency**

Any frequency within the electromagnetic spectrum associated with radio wave propagation

Synonym: Cordless, RF, Wireless

#### **RCA**

See also: Phono Connector

## **Rear Projection Screen**

Translucent material used for projection from behind Synonym: Picture Sheet, Projection Screen, RP Screen

#### **Reel to Reel**

See also: Tape Deck

#### **Remote Head**

Remotely controlled apparatus that allows for pan and tilt of the camera

Synonym: Hot Head (trade name)

## Reproducer

See also: Tape Deck

#### Resolution

Refers to the sharpness and clarity of an image

#### RF

See also: Radio Frequency

#### RF connector

See also: F Connector

#### **RGB-HV**

See also: Component Video

#### **RJ-11**

See also: RJ-11 Connection

#### **RJ-11 Connection**

Short for Registered Jack-11, the most common telephone connection

Synonym: RJ-11

## **Roll Up Screen**

Projection surface attached to a roller and housed in a case that can be

suspended or floor mounted Synonym: Cradle Screen

#### **RP Screen**

See also: Rear Projection Screen

# S

#### S-VHS

Enhanced form of standard VHS video tape recording and playback

#### S-Video

Method of processing and distributing video

#### **S-Video Connector**

Small 5 pin round connector used to transmit S-video signals

#### **Scene Machine**

Trade name (GAM Products) See also: Slide Projector

#### Screen

See also: Projection Surface

#### **Show Control**

Digital system that manages the operations of multiple production elements

Synonym: Automation, Automation Control System, Automation System, PLC

## Signal

Variations in voltage, amperage or electromagnetic waves that are processed by a system

## **Slide Projector**

Displays still transparency film images

Synonym: Carousel, Pani, PIGI®, Image Pro®, Scene Machine

#### **SMPTE**

Society for Motion Picture and Television Engineers - group that develops motion picture and television technical standards.

#### **SMPTE Time Code**

See also: Time Code

#### **Splitter**

Device used to provide two or more signal outputs from a single source Synonym: Line Splitter, Mic Splitter

#### **Sticks**

See also: Tripod Stand

#### **SVGA Monitor**

Super Video Graphics Array system

## **Systems Integrator**

Person responsible for configuring different systems components for interaction with each other

# T

## **Tabletop**

See also: Tabletop Screen

## **Tabletop Screen**

Self supported small screen that usually sits on a table or counter Synonym: Tabletop

## **Tape Deck**

Machine for recording and/or playback of signals on a magnetic tape; Requires additional components to be audible Synonym: Tape Recorder

# **Tape Operator**

Person who sets-up, loads and operates audio and/or video tape sources Synonym: Playback Person

# **Tape Recorder**

Self contained machine for recording and/or playback of signals on a magnetic tape See also: Tape Deck

#### **Television Set**

Display device with a tuner for television Synonym: TV

#### Tie

Short length of flexible material that attaches items together Synonym: Tie-lines, Zip Tie

#### **Tie-lines**

See also: Tie

#### Tilt

Vertical, up and down, movement of equipment

#### **Time Code**

- 1) Electronic signals that allow for precise timing of visual and audio content in film and video; 2) Electronic signals used to synchronize various show control systems
- 2) Synonym: SMPTE Time Code

#### **Tracks**

See also: Multitrack

## Tripod

See also: Tripod Stand

## **Tripod Screen**

Projection screen supported by a tripod stand, usually a rollup screen

## **Tripod Stand**

Three legged support device Synonym: Sticks, Tripod

#### Twisted Pair

See also: Twisted Pair Wires

#### **Twisted Pair Wires**

Pair of individually insulated conductors twisted together and used to transmit electrical signals or power

Synonym: Twisted Pair

## Ty-wrap

See also: Cable Tie

# U

#### **U-Matic**

See also: Magnetic Tape

#### **Unbalanced Signal**

Two conductor audio signal with one conductor grounded

#### **USB Connector**

Universal Serial Bus, small rectangular connector used to transmit digital data



#### **VCR**

See also: Video Cassette Recorder

#### **VGA Monitor**

Video Graphics Array display system

#### **VHS**

See also: Magnetic Tape

#### **Video Cassette Recorder**

Equipment used for the tape recording and playback of video programming Synonym: VCR

## **Video Display**

See also: Video Monitor

#### **Video Monitor**

Electronic visual display device without television tuner Synonym: Video Display, Monitor

## **Video Router**

Switching system that sends video signals from one or more sources to several destinations

#### **Video Switcher**

Video device for selection of sources and their processing

# W

#### **Water Screen**

Projection surface created by pumping water into a thin, flat sheet Synonym: Fog Screen, Mist Screen

## Wire Tie

See also: Cable Tie

## Wire Wrap

See also: Cable Tie

#### **Wireless**

See also: Radio Frequency

# X

#### **XLR Connector**

Trade Name (ITT-Cannon); Multi-pin locking connector Synonym: 3 Pin, 4 Pin, 5 Pin, XLR

#### **XVGA Monitor**

Extended Video Graphics Array system



## Y cable

Three signal cables wired together allowing a signal to be divided (1 into 2) or combined (2 into 1)

## Y,Y-B,Y-R

## **Zip Tie**

Variable focal length lens Synonym: Zoom
