Personal Responsibility

A list of best practices for all Scene Shop and Stage Operations for all present in your facility (Supervisors, Workers, Teachers, Students, Volunteers, etc.) to practice at all times.

- Sick workers or those suspected of exposure to COVID-19 should not be in the workplace. Follow IATSE [1], OSHA [2], and CDC [3] guidelines for work attendance.
- Cover the nose and mouth with a cloth or disposable face mask per OSHA [4] and CDC guidelines. [5]
 - Face coverings with an unfiltered vent will not prevent potential spread of infection by the wearer. [6]
 - Assess tasks in advance to identify work that is altered by masks such as blowing sawdust out of one's way when using a jigsaw. Provide alternate means to avoid the removal of the mask during work. [7]
 - Follow CDC guidance regarding cloth face coverings as PPE: [8]
 - Cloth masks are not to be worn with or instead of respiratory protection when respirators are needed. [9]
- Practice frequent hand-washing per CDC Guidelines. [10]
 - Follow the Wet/Lather/Scrub/Rinse/Dry guidelines. [11]
 - Use hand sanitizer that contains 60% or greater alcohol when cleaning with soap and water is not possible. [12]
 - If possible, choose hand sanitizer stations that are touch-free. [13]
- Limit access to all production areas and support spaces to only workers essential for operations. Visitors should only be permitted into the space if pre-arranged and room capacities permit. [1]
