Considerations for Performances

General Practices

- Please adhere first and foremost to the CDC guidelines on COVID-19, social distancing, appropriate mask-wearing, and your state and local policies and procedures. [1]
- A Health and Safety Coordinator should be present at all rehearsals and performances to ensure that COVID-19 guidelines and check-in procedures are followed.

Audience Placement

- Producers should consult with local and state health authorities to determine the appropriate distance of the audience away from the performers. [1]
- The performing area and audience areas should be clearly delineated and established to maintain appropriate social distance between individual audience members, as well as between the audience and the performers. [1]
- All performers who are blocked to move into the audience area should wear masks and maintain appropriate social distance based on current CDC and local government guidelines. [1]
