6.1 Report on the Fees Structure and implemented changes – Blackmon (5m)



Goal: achieving equity across all programs Our award programs are equitable with other, similar awards fees Currently asking of all our programs: why is there a fee? All current recommendations are looking at cost offsets/coverage/operational concerns

Discussion: do direct and indirect costs and benefits balance? How do we fund Student Assistants if there are no fees? There are two important notes:

Have never been truly volunteers and should not be designated so Need for it as a bridge program for young professionals as well New approach: this could be a collective mentorship for Conference Assistants. Applying for this implies some kind of financial hardship, how to approach the real hardship of travel and accommodation? More opportunities to connect with training opportunities and direct contact with companies and possible employers Anyone who applies gets discounted conference rate, commits to fifteen hours, and gets a certificate pf credit for their learning Blackmon and Everett will overhaul what is on the website; they will clarify details, learning objectives, and end goals They will post talking points to the Basecamp for Board members NEXT YEAR the program will evolve to its new form Gillett volunteered Board members as mentor and badge scanners
